NOTICE OF RACE

Saturday, September 12, 2015

Organizing Authority: Indian Point Yacht Club, Mahone Bay, Nova Scotia, Canada



- RULES: Series races will be governed by the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of sailing (RRS) and the prescriptions of Sail Canada
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: International One Design Yachts (IOD). Participants must be a member in good standing of a Sail Canada/Sail Nova Scotia recognized Yacht Club or of their own National Sailing Association
- 3. REGISTRATION: \$50.00 per boat. Boats will be able to register and pay on-line at www.indianpointyachtclub.ca
- 4. SCHEDULE SATURDAY SEPT 12TH
 - 1300 Start of 1st race and subsequent races
 - After Race BBQ compliments of IPYC at the wharf with the boat lift in Indian Point.
 Support vessels welcome to raft- up
- 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Available at www.indianpointyachtclub.ca prior to September 10th
- 6. VENUE: In or around Indian Point in Mahone Bay
- 7. COURSES: 4 Windward/Leeward 1st course will be announced on VHF and displayed on the white Board. Each course is identified by a course colour flag. Subsequent courses will be announced on VHF after the finish of the previous race and indicated by course flag. Possible courses to be sailed will be in the sailing instructions. The final race of the day will start prior to 1600hrs.
- 8. SCORING: One completed race constitutes a series however if four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her lowest score.
- 9. INSURANCE: Each boat participating in shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000 or the equivalent. Proof of insurance may be requested by the organizing body.
- 10. ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT: Electronic and electrical compasses, performance instruments and systems and electronic communications systems are prohibited with the exception of electronic watches and stop watches and VHF radios as per the sailing instructions.
- 11. RADIO COMMUNICATION: Boats are required, for safety reasons to carry an operational marine VHF radio. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 12. PRIZES: "Overall" Trophy will be awarded to the top finisher based on the cumulative results of the series.
- 13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: Competitors participate in the series entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, or during or after the series.
