

## STARTING INSTRUCTIONS

### INDIAN POINT YACHT CLUB

#### 2018 SEASON

Races shall be started using the following signals. Times shall be taken from the visual signals: the absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded.

| <u>Minutes before starting signal</u> | <u>Visual Signal</u> | <u>Sound Signal</u> | <u>Means</u>        |

| 6                                     | Orange flag          | 3 short             | Attention signal    |
| 5                                     | Class flag           | 1 short             | Warning signal      |
| 4                                     | P Flag               | 1 short             | Preparatory signal  |
| 1                                     | P Flag removed       | 1 long              | One minute to start |
| 0                                     | Class flag removed   | 1 short             | Starting Signal     |

The warning signal for each succeeding class shall be made with the starting signal of the preceding class

#### RECALLS

##### INDIVIDUAL RECALLS

If a boat is over the line early the race committee will display the X flag with one sound. The flag shall be displayed until all such boats have sailed completely to the pre-start side of its starting line and crossed the start line again.

##### GENERAL RECALLS

If the Race Committee is unable to identify the boats over the line early, or if there has been an error in the starting procedure, the race committee may signal a general recall: by displaying the First Substitute with two sounds. The warning signal for a new start for the recalled class shall be made one minute after the First Substitute is removed (one sound)
